Please ensure your children come into school in their uniform but have their P.E. kit to change into.



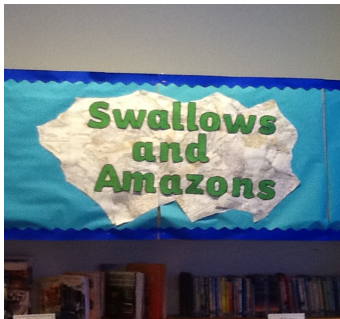
Star of the Week
