Drop Off/Pick Up Updates

As we try to reduce congestion and help ease the parking/traffic at drop off and pick up times, we would ask that parents/carers adhere to the following.

- Use the one-way system around the triangle.
- Avoid turning in the road/cul-de-sac opposite school.
- Stay in your car until you are next to the footpath – there will be staff in high visibility jackets ushering cars to move down when there are spaces.
- **Wait at the top** (an adult from school will direct you where to stop and wait until it is your time to move down).
- **DO NOT PARK AT THE TOP AND WALK ALL THE WAY DOWN!** This is causing a bottle neck at the top and cars are unable to move. We have school staff supporting collection times and would appreciate it if parents/grandparents/carers would work with us to help ease the traffic and make it safer for our pupils and families.
