I am excited to share that today we had the honour of welcoming Australian Education Minister, The Hon Jo Palmer MLC, to Yanwath Primary School, along with 7 other high-level educational research professionals from Victoria and Tasmania. They have been in the country for one week and met with 4 trusts in England as part of a research tour to improve education in Australia. During the visit, our guests observed lessons and spoke with staff and pupils regarding strategies the school has adopted over the past year. Following our work with One World Institute, staff have implemented and developed strategies to ensure pupils 'think hard in lessons' and that teaching and learning is at a pupil's point of need.

Whilst it was a pleasure hosting these international visitors, I believe it was more of a pleasure for them to meet our amazing Yanwath pupils! I am incredibly proud of how polite, and welcoming the children were and how articulate they were when sharing the learning that has been taking place in classrooms, since the beginning of the year.

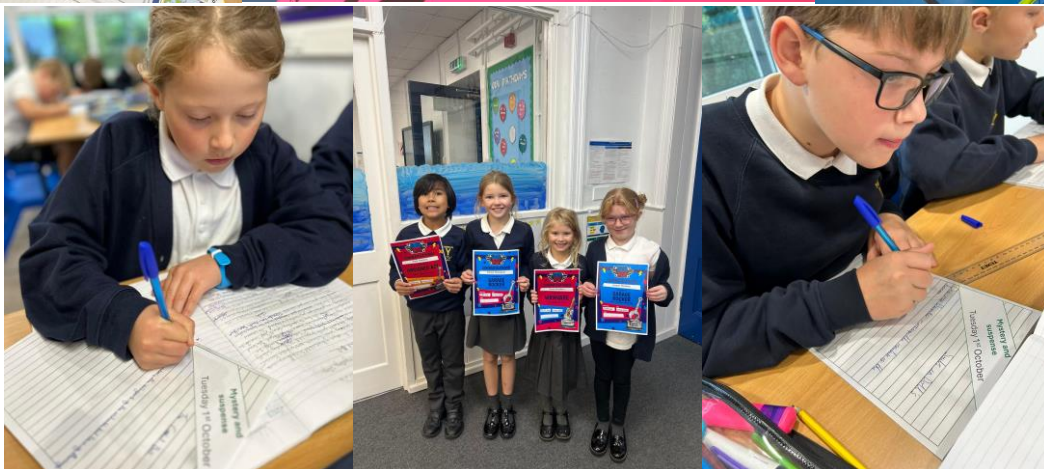
